Though once called "rare", this butterfly is better described as local. I have seen it in several places within a few kilometres of my home in Aranda in the ACT, most commonly on the lower south-west slopes of Black Mountain in late October or early November. It prefers open grassy fields where *lomandra filiformis* grows.
